

Internal Behavioural Education Process

Chewing Gum

Student is asked to dispose of the gum immediately

Student is requested to return at break time to complete the following:

- Grab a scraper and gloves
- Go to the duty teacher
- Walk with duty teacher and scrape any gum found on the concrete
- If there is no gum, student is requested to pick up rubbish

If the student does not present to RTC actions include:

- **Referral to Class Teacher**
- Behaviour Plan

If the behaviour is repeated, **refer to DP.**

Further actions may include:

- Behaviour Plan
- Behaviour Monitor Card
- Internal suspension



As with all behavioural processes, there is discretion as to which of the options above are utilised. There will also be circumstances that fall outside of these parameters. Each situation should be carefully considered and the Deputy Principal consulted if another pathway is deemed more suitable for the circumstances.

DP outcomes may also take into account previous behaviour, reviews and wellbeing.
