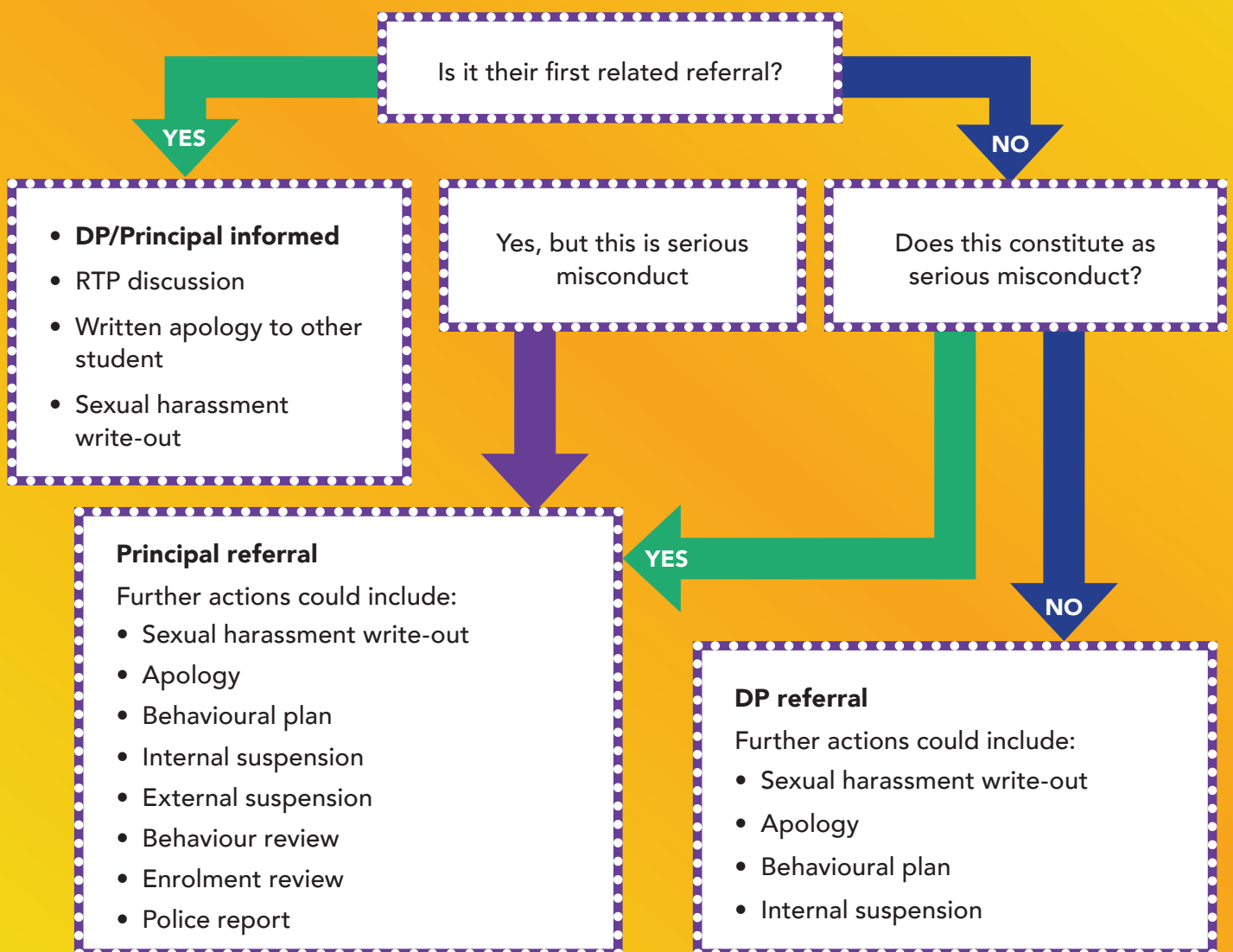


Internal Behavioural Education Process

Sexual Harassment

Sexual harassment can take various forms and can include: unwelcome touch, sexual or suggestive comments or gestures, unwelcome requests of a sexual nature, leering/moaning, sexually offensive comments/communications including online, showing/sending explicit material. Please consider the impact of other students in relation to sexual harassment and provide support/wellbeing referrals as necessary.

As with all behavioural processes, there is discretion as to which of the options above are utilised. There will also be circumstances that fall outside of these parameters. Each situation should be carefully considered and DP consulted if another pathway is deemed more suitable for the circumstances.

DP outcomes may also take into account previous behaviour, reviews and wellbeing.
